

OYSP NON-COMPANY POLICIES 2022-23

COMMITMENT: It is important to understand that signing up for OYSP classes your financial commitment is for one school year season (August-May). In the event that we have to close and go to a zoom schedule due to Covid related concerns, you will be allowed to discontinue your classes and your monthly charge. You must notify us of this in writing via email. However as long as regular, in-person options are still being offered, your commitment will still be for the full season. The only other exceptions are if your family moves out of the city/state or if your child is injured and unable to continue. In that event, the directors should also be notified immediately in writing at oconeeyouth@gmail.com.

TUITION: Tuition rates are broken down into 10 payments from August-May with May 2023 (last month) due in advance at the time of registration along with a one-time registration fee of \$35 per student. Tuition is not pro-rated for any reason. All closings/holidays are taken into account up front. Tuition rates are posted on the registration page on our website: oconeeyouth.com/registration.

PAYMENTS: As mentioned above, tuition is broken down into (10) payments and must be paid by automatic credit card payments. In person, monthly payments by cash or check are not accepted. All payments are made with our automatic pre-authorized credit card program online. Credit cards will be charged on the 1st of each month. The only exception is the month of August, which is charged on the 15th. Remember, when you sign up online, you are automatically charged the \$35 registration fee plus the last month tuition (May). All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Please be diligent in keeping your credit card information updated online as a \$25 late fee will be charged after the 10th for every month an account carries a balance. **ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL IN ORDER FOR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE COSTUMES AND PERFORM IN THE END OF THE YEAR RECITAL.**

DISCOUNTS: There is a 10% sibling discount on tuition for families with two or more children enrolled.

2023 Spring Showcase

The Spring Showcase dates for 2023 takes place at our home theater on site, Oconee Youth Theater (1050 Jamestown Blvd in Watkinsville). All students are expected to participate with the exception of voice/piano students and any acting classes, if applicable. The dates for the Spring Showcase are listed below.

SPRING SHOWCASE DATES:

Saturday, April 27th, 2023 (All Broadway Babies, Pre-K & K classes) NOTE: We will still have classes in May for the younger ones

Thursday-Friday-Saturday-Sunday, May 11-14th, 2023 (All classes 1st grade and up)

NOTE for 1st grade and up: Even though the Spring Showcase has 4 total dates (Thursday-Sunday), most classes will just perform on (2) of those dates. For example in 2022, 3rd grade and up classes had a show Thursday night @ 7 pm and a matinee on Saturday afternoon @ 3:30 pm. 1st-3rd grade classes had a show Friday night @ 7 pm & Saturday afternoon @ Noon.

RECITAL FEE/COSTUME CHARGES: There will be a \$25 recital fee per child posted/paid on November 15th. This fee helps cover all the extra work/time and energy for all the teachers involved in creating and carrying out the Spring Showcase. They are many extra hours that go into making the show possible!

Costume fees will also be posted/paid on 11/15 at \$75 per costume per class. Tights are your responsibility. We will let you know the exact color/brand during costume distribution. Your child must have the exact style/color of shoes designated for your child's class and can be purchased or ordered at the studio during Open House or at DanceStyle in Athens.

DRESS CODE

BROADWAY BABIES/PRE-K/K: Pink or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. **GIRLS:** hair in a bun with a net. Please no skirts or anything extraneous like jewelry that might distract a young dancer. **BALLET:** Solid leotard, pink ballet shoes, pink tights. Chiffon ballet skirts only. **GIRLS:** Hair in a bun with hair net.

BOYS: Tank top with black jazz pants and black ballet shoes.

JAZZ/TAP: Leotard, tan tights, dance shorts or jazz pants.

GIRLS: Hair secured in a ponytail. **BOYS:** Tank top with black jazz pants and jazz/tap shoes.

MUSICAL THEATER: Comfortable street clothes and sneakers or jazz shoes.

HIP HOP: Casual dance attire and hip hop sneakers.
